
CALCULATION OF AGGREGATE OF MARKS FOR DIPLOMA (FRESH & LE), LE-Working Professionals & PDIS ADMISSION 2025-26

For calculation of aggregate marks for admission during the academic session 2025-26, the applicants are advised to take into consideration of all the subjects appearing in the marksheet. For this purpose, if there is any additional subject, the additional subject name and marks are also to be included. Candidates passing from BSE(O), CHSE(O) & other Boards are to take note of the process of mark entry as shown in this document as an example.

CBSE



In the above marksheet (CBSE) shared as an example, there are six subjects. The maximum total marks are 600 and the candidate has secured (66+90+74+66+75+84) =455. The aggregate marks of the candidate will be calculated as: 455/600=75.83%.

ICSE:

In case of candidates passing qualifying examination from ICSE Board, the marks secured in each subject need to be considered for calculation of aggregate marks.

In the above marksheet (ICSE) shown as an example, both total marks secured and percentage of marks are reflected. Calculation of aggregate marks for admission during the Academic Year 2025-26 will be done by considering total marks. The maximum full marks are 1000 out of which the candidate has secured (96+99+99+100+90+90+90+100+100) = 982 marks. The aggregate marks will be calculated as: 982/1000 = 98.20%.

Similarly for all other boards calculation of aggregate marks will of the same process.
